

SIMPCW GENERAL ELECTION 2012

Additional Nomination Forms

For Persons Seeking Nomination

With recent revisions in the **SIMPCW CUSTOM ELECTION REGULATIONS (September 6, 2011)**, two new **(additional)** documents for persons seeking to be candidates are required. These are being introduced to provide additional clarity of nomination criteria. They must be included as part of the candidate's nomination documents. They are as follows:

Simpcw Candidate's Residency Declaration

Persons wishing to be nominated for positions requiring "**Ordinarily On-Reserve**" residency as required in Part III and Schedule C, will be required to declare that they meet these standards. Verification of residency (as set out in Schedule C) is **not** required to accompany the Declaration, but may be requested by the Electoral Officer at a later point in time.

Nomination Form

This document is referred to in the regulations, and has been used in previous elections. It sets out in writing, with signatures, the nominators and acceptance of nomination by the candidate.


These forms will be available at the Nomination Meeting.

For Those Persons who wish to attend the Nomination Meeting.

- The **Nomination Form** requires that the candidate, nominator and elector seconding the nomination, be present to complete the documents prior to the end of the meeting.
- The **Simpcw Candidate's Residency Declaration** can be witnessed either by the Electoral Officer or any other person over the age of 18.

For Those Persons who are unable to attend the Nomination Meeting.

The Residency Declaration can be witnessed by any person over the age of 18.
