Regarding: **Drug Dealers Entering SFN Reserve Lands**

This issue of drug dealers coming into our community has come up during the last couple of Chief & Council meetings.

To date, we have completed three (3) BCR's (Band Council Resolutions) to ban three known drug dealers off our reserve. The BCRs which include the names and vehicle descriptions have been delivered to the Barriere R.C.M.P detachment. In addition, the R.C.M.P. have been informed of which houses these unwelcome visitors have been delivering drugs to.

Chief & Council take this issue very seriously and the community needs to be aware that the drug dealers will be reported, they will be caught and could potentially face jail time.

This entire community knows of the drug issues on the reserve, it is no secret. If you see a drug deal taking place, if you see a drug dealer driving on the reserve, if you know who sells drugs, please phone the Barriere R.C.M.P. detachment.

These calls can be confidential, but the R.C.M.P. cannot act on second hand information and must be informed as soon as possible. If there is no answer, leave a message and an officer will return your call. We have spoken with Corporal Mike Mucha and he is aware of the drug dealer issue in our community and is willing to help us in any way he can.
