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WHAT'S THE JOB?

Simpco Resources LLP is looking for an experienced **HSE Manager** to provide leadership and guidance regarding HSE programs and mentoring and coaching to site personnel. Under the general supervision of the Senior Management team, the HSE Manager actively promotes the health, safety, and environmental culture to all levels of employees with the policies and procedures of the Health, Safety and Environmental Manual. Leads planning, managing, documenting, and reporting on health and safety activities, training, procedures, policies, commitments, incidents, and statistics for the site. Responsible to assist project teams in day-to-day operations by influence, developing, and implementing project safety plans to help achieve zero incidents.

This is a CONTRACT POSITION requiring in camp stays on a specified rotation located in the BC Interior. Position requires working out of town, includes weekend work, and work in varying terrain and weather conditions.

WHAT YOU DO?

- Create an environment in which employees are looking to the HSE Department for assistance, guidance, and solutions.
- Mentor other project HSE personnel and workers in the field.
- Support field managers in finding safe solutions to work challenges.
- Review and development JHAs and SWPs for content and completeness.
- Support and assist in the development of return to work and modified work programs.
- Implement site-wide permit and compliance obligations.
- Provide site specific safety orientation to workers, owners, and clients.

- Lead Accident/Incident investigations and provide input for studies and analysis of accident trends.
- Prepare and assist with external safety audits.
- Coordinate with environmental issues.
- Gather and provide statistical information to estimating for tender packages.
- Conduct workplace inspections and audits in conjunction with the JOHSC Committee.
- Manage departmental documentation and PPE to maintain compliance with corporate and regulatory requirements.
- Develop workplace plans – such as CoVID protection controls, emergency evacuations, fire emergency, traffic controls, fall protection.

- University Degree in Occupational Health & Safety, Industrial Relations or any other relevant field of study OR Technical College Degree in Environment, Hygiene and Work Safety combined with significant related experience.
