WHO ARE WE:

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WHAT'S THE JOB?

SRLLP is seeking experienced and highly motivated individuals for **Occupational First Aid Level 3 (OFA3)** to join the company's first aid team. These positions are for skilled applicants who can quickly adapt to changes and maintain a calm professional demeanor while providing onsite first aid and emergency response to ill/injured workers onsite. Prior experience is preferred. Positions will be an on-call basis to start, with an opportunity to gain full time, seasonal employment (pending client needs).

Workers will be situated at work locations between Barriere, BC and Jasper, AB. Position may require working out of town, can include weekend work, and work in varying terrain and weather conditions.

WHAT YOU DO?

- Actively participates in promoting our occupational health and safety programs.
- Readily assumes all related first aid attendant duties.
- Must always be available to provide treatment as quickly as possible if a worker is injured.
- Promptly provides injured workers with a level of care within the scope of OFA3 training.
- Objectively records reported signs and symptoms of injuries and/or exposures.
- Refers injured workers to medical treatment if injuries are serious or beyond the scope of an OFA3 training.
- Maintains and ensures first aid equipment, and facilities must be ready to receive injured workers within three to five minutes of being called.
- Acts as a backup for absent first aid attendants.
- Records accurate head counts in case of emergency.
- Acts as the sole point of contact for emergency and non-emergency medical situations as they arise, consulting with medical professionals as required.

- Understands the company Return to Work plan for injured workers and assist supervisors. and/or safety in upholding the RTW plan for injured workers on their jobsite.
- Provides stabilization and pre-hospital care for medevac cases.
- Maintains a professional and courteous relationship with employees and subcontractors.
- Provides excellent customer service, radio check ins, report writing, and other duties as required.

WHO ARE WE LOOKING FOR?

- OFA Level 3 Certification
- 3-5 years industry experience is preferred
- Compliance with all Occupational Health and Safety Regulations/Standards
- Good working knowledge of site Emergency Response Plans
- Strong work ethic, communication, organizational and time management skills
- Ability to work alone and productively in a team environment
- Knowledge of computers and mobile apps is an asset
- Flexibility of shift scheduling, willingness to travel, work long hours in remote work location is a must
- Must be willing and able to obtain valid PCST (Pipeline Construction Safety Training), Transportation of Dangerous Goods and Ground Disturbance Lvl 2 certificates. Training is provided
- Meets the **WorkSafe BC** Occupational First Aid Statement of Fitness
- Must be physically and mentally capable of safely and effectively performing the required duties
- Valid Class 5 driver's license and clear driver's abstract - Class 4 an asset

Work Conditions:

- 2-week shift rotations and/or 7-day shift rotations includes night shift.
- Wildlife awareness as certain sites may be in remote locations.
- Selected applicants must provide their own steel toe boots. 6" high, from the bottom of the sole
