- 2-day of hands-on First Aid training
- Equivalent to WorkSafe BC Level 1
- CPR Level C for adult, child and infant
- AED (Automatic External Defibrillator) procedures
- Choking procedures for adult, child and infant
- Opioid/Fentanyl awareness
- Realistic community-relevant response scenarios
- *After successful completion of the course, communities will be given a Level 2 First Aid kit as well as an in-service AED*
- Recommended class size is 1- 12 people
- Facilitated and instructed by FNESS instructors
- Canadian Red Cross certification is valid for 3 years
