WHO ARE WE LOOKING FOR?

- Have a minimum of 3-5 years' pipeline construction experience.
- Must have experience overseeing and directing crews.
- Possess and maintain a clean driver's abstract and valid full-driver's license appropriate to the requirements of the vehicle being driven.
- Certified in the following training requirements or willing and able to obtain the following:
 - Leadership for Safety Excellence certificate,
 - PCST (Pipeline Construction Safety Training),
 - First Aid Level C with CPR,
 - H2S Alive and Ground Disturbance Level 2 certificates.
- Performs duties with little supervision, works in a safe and positive team environment.
- Able to perform physically demanding tasks and stand for extended periods of time.
- Able to lift 50 lbs. regularly.
- Experience and/or certified operating skid steer is an asset.
- Must meet Trans Mountain qualification process.
